Open to members and non-members, however NON MEMBERS to purchase Day Membership Show Card for this show. Day membership must be purchased from VHS head office at least 2 weeks in advance of the show, at a cost of £25.00 Payment by telephone and a Credit or Debit card is required. A day membership show card and age badge will be provided. Owners who are not competing are not required to be a member.

All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

Members and Day members must carry their current VHS membership cards in the ring and produce these on request - no exceptions will be made. No card no entry or qualification.

VHS Supreme Final qualification. Competitors placed 1st and 2nd in each class will qualify directly for the corresponding class at the VHS Supreme Final, to be held at the National Veteran Championships. 29th - 31st August 2025. For classes with fewer than 5 entries forward, Supreme Final qualifications will be awarded at the judge's discretion and are not guaranteed.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 3rd - 4th in each class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals.

VHS M&M Supreme Final qualification. This is only given at the judges discretion and will be to the highest placed M&M in each class to qualify for the VHS M&M Supreme Final at the National Veteran Championships. Show Card/Day Membership to be signed. Only open to registered M&M breeds.

Members and Day-members will have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Day-members must become full VHS members within 21 days and exchange their day-showing card for a full showing card in order to validate their qualification for the Supreme or Regional Final qualification. Regional Finals are open to members only.

If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line on the day. Day members must become full VHS members in order to enter the Supreme Final.

Once you have a Supreme Qualification you must enter the Supreme Final within 21 days of gaining this qualification - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, 29th -31st August 2025. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule. Entries on-line via the VHS website.

It is strongly recommended that all members and exhibitors carry **PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE** for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence.

Rules and Conditions of Qualification and Entry

No horse/pony under 4 years of age may be ridden on the Showground. Competitors MUST be a minimum of 3 years of age to ride any horse/pony on the showground. Anyone leading a LR pony must be a minimum of 16 years. Riders in LR /FR classes MUST use a snaffle bridle only.

Any stallions must be ridden/handled by a competent person with a minimum age of 14 years.

Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. All riders must wear correctly fitting headgear to PAS015 (ENS1384 are no longer allowed), or higher, whilst mounted anywhere on the Showground. Junior members are also compelled to wear them when competing in hand. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the ring.

No person who has a conviction (or pending conviction) for animal cruelty will be permitted to compete.

Ages of horse/pony will be 1st of January in the current year.

Spurs are permitted for Senior riders only (aged over 18 years).

Excessive use of whips is forbidden and will result in disqualification. Whips must be of regulation length.

Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts them selves in a manner which may be deemed to bring the Show into disrepute, or who is acting in a way which may be abusive to any animal, person, official, judge or steward will be disqualified from competition and will be escorted off the Showground. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.

Fall of a horse/pony in any class requires that the horse/pony is to be lead from the ring. The competitor will be eliminated.

No late competitors will be allowed into the ring in any ridden class in which the initial trot has commenced: likewise, for in-hand sections, no late competitors will be allowed in the ring after the first horse/pony has begun it's trot out.

Entry fees are non refundable under any circumstances.

The organisers and judges reserve the right to refuse an entry in the event of any unsoundness such as lameness, coughing or dangerous behavior etc

The ruling of Judges/Officials is Final. The organisers reserve the right to substitute judges as necessary.

The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or substitute classes as deemed necessary.

No lunging will be allowed on the showground.

Any person wishing to make a complaint, must do so on the day of the event, within 30 minutes of the alleged complaint, accompanied by £50 administration fee, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times and are prohibited in Café and viewing area.

Push chairs and prams are discouraged near any horse/ponies.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

No persons are allowed in the horse walkways unless they are riding or leading a horse/pony.

NO Horses to be left tied to horseboxes and trailers on the car park. Under no circumstances must haynets be tied to the side of a horsebox or trailer. Anyone breaking these rules will be disqualified from the competition and asked to leave the showground

Horseboxes and Trailers must not be skipped out onto the showground: please use the muck heaps provided.

All rubbish must be taken home or disposed of in the bins provided on the showground: anyone found to have dumped rubbish will be fined £50 clean up fee.

Any accidents must be reported to the Show Office
